Headline CPI inflation, published by the Central Agency for Public Mobilization and Statistics on December 10, 2017, declined to 0.97 percent (m/m) in November 2017 from 1.10 percent (m/m) in October 2017. The annual rate declined to 25.98 percent in November from 30.82 percent in October.

Core CPI inflation, computed by the Central Bank of Egypt, recorded 1.31 percent (m/m) in November 2017 compared to 0.70 percent (m/m) in October 2017. The annual rate declined to 25.54 percent in November from 30.53 percent in October.
