Team **r3billions** took first place scoring 600 points, Team **easyHunt** was second and Team **0xDiablos** came out third scoring 400 points each. These top three teams will now participate in the Arab Regional CTF, to be held in September, in Cairo. And the regional winning team will represent the Arab world at the global finals in Tokyo, in November.
