TEN AUC PROFESSORS IN STANFORD UNIVERSITY LIST

OF TOP 2% SCIENTISTS WORLDWIDE

November 16, 2020, Cairo – Ten professors from The American University in Cairo (AUC) have been named in the [Stanford University- Elsevier list](#) of the top 2% most-cited scientists in various disciplines worldwide. The database is created by experts at Stanford University, based on data from Elsevier's Scopus, the abstract and citation database. The database includes the top 2% scientists in 22 scientific fields and 176 subfields and provides standardized information on citations, h-index, coauthorship-adjusted hm-index, citations to papers in different authorship positions, and a composite indicator.
