These state-of-the-art cath labs will support doctors and medical staff in fighting life threatening diseases such as coronary artery disease, stroke, and tumors.

Alameda Healthcare Group have previously partnered with Siemens Healthineers Egypt in several projects, most recently with the addition of the cutting-edge Biograph Horizon PET/CT scanner at As-Salam International Hospital in Maadi, Cairo.
