The partnership aims to raise awareness on sustainable waste management to address concerns related to environmental pollution and public health.

LOCALE will showcase aesthetic artwork created by local artists using industrial waste collected from IDG's e² October industrial park, with the purpose of raising awareness around waste management and encouraging waste prevention, reuse, and recycling behaviour. In collaboration with Art D'Egypte, e2 Alamein will host 9 art installations made mostly from recycled materials.

The partnership aims to ignite innovation and creativity to explore smarter ways of handling industrial waste as part of IDG's strategy to plan, build, and operate smart and sustainable industrial parks with the environment in mind, and to collaborate with the local community to share ideas and resources that ultimately lead to not only economic gains but also improvements to our eco-system. It aims to engage and inspire youth on how to play an active role in protecting the environment and paves the way for future collaborations between culture and business for that purpose.

The e2 Alamein eco-sustainable park, which is expected to be operational before the end of the year, spans 2.7 sqkm and promotes a circular economy by boasting a flood management system that helps ration water usage and prevents leakage, a supply chain integration system that constantly recycles factories' waste into raw materials that can be used by others, and the main admin building was constructed using sustainable materials. IDG's parks are designed to surpass international standards with energy efficiency strategies, aned among the new sustainable projects implemented in e² Alamein is a rainwater harvesting system that will substantially decrease the park's dependency on city water.

"We are particulary excited to host this first-of-its-kind cultural festival at our state-of-the-art sustainable industrial park. By fostering creativity and innovation through the collaboration between industry and art, we want to promote the value of sustainable industrial development," said IDG Managing Director Shady William. "Our parks are built for the future, and we believe that businesses can thrive operationally and financially while safeguarding the planet. Through the efficient use of resources and waste reduction, we can maximize value for businesses, society, and the environment, all at once."
