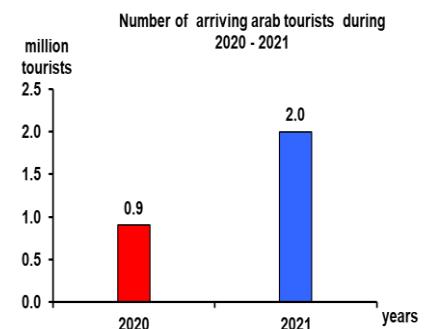
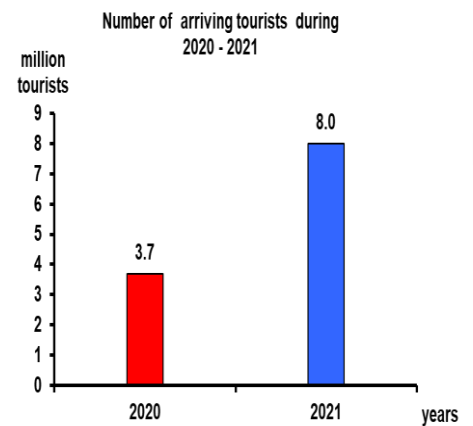
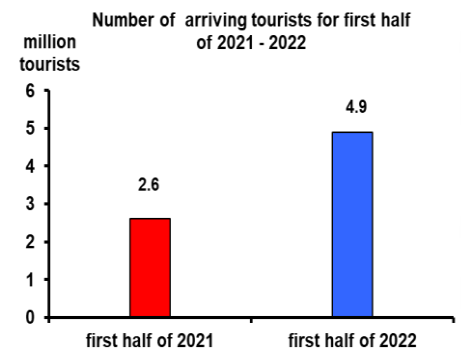
World Tourism Day

85.4% Increase in number of tourists during the first half of 2022

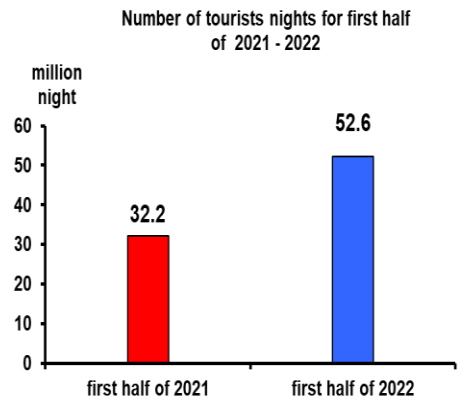
Central Agency for Public Mobilization and Statistics Issued today 27/ 9 / 2022 a press release about the tourism movement on the occasion of World Tourism Day in 27 th September annually .The day which marks the adoption of World Tourism Organization (WTO) in 1970. It has been celebrated for the first time in 1980 . It aims to enhance awareness among international community of importance of tourism and its social, cultural, political and economic values The celebration this year will be held Under the slogan " Rethinking tourism " hosted by Indonesia.

The most important indicators are as follows:

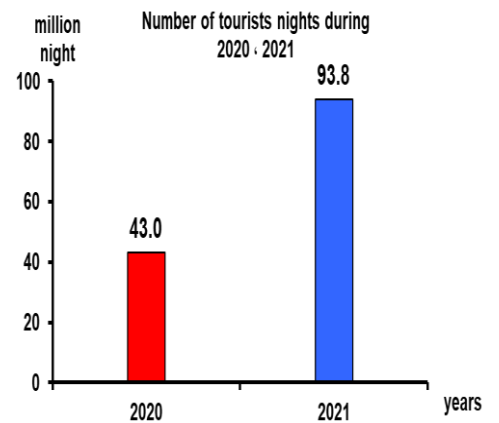
- Number of arriving tourists from all over the world reached 4.9 million tourists during the first half of 2022, compared to 2.6 million tourists during the first half of 2021, an increase by 85.4%
- Number of arriving tourists from all over the world reached 8.0 million tourists in 2021 compared to 3.7 million tourists in 2020, an increase by 117.5 %.
- Eastern Europe recorded the first area for sending tourists during 2021 by 50.6% , followed by Middle East by 18.9 % , followed by Western Europe by 16.4 % , Followed by Africa by 7.1 % , .
- Total number of arriving Arab tourists from Arab countries reached 2.0 million tourists in 2021 compared to 0.9 million tourists in 2020, an increase by 114.9 %.



- Number of tourists nights spent by departing tourists reached 52.6 million nights during the first half of 2022 (January- June) compared to 32.2 million nights during the same period of 2021 (January- June), an increase by 63.6%.

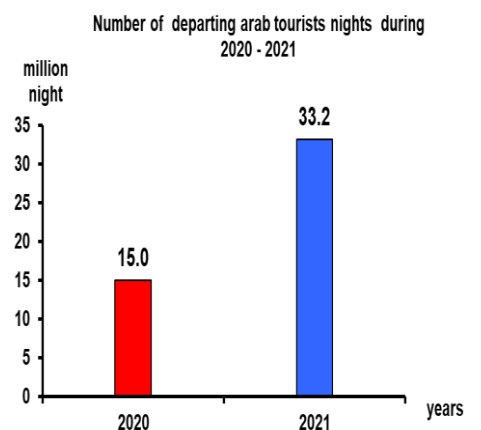


- Total number of tourist nights spent by departing tourists reached 93.8 million nights in 2021 compared to 43.0 million nights in 2020, an increase by 118.3%.



- Average number of tourist nights reached 12.4 nights in 2021 compared to 11.4 nights in 2020.

- Total number of tourist nights spent by departing Arab tourists reached 33.2 million nights in 2021, compared to 15.0 million nights in 2020, an increase by 121.6 %.
